**OPENS**

a comparative evaluation procedure to award a teaching post in the Environmental Engineering master degree program for Academic Year 2014/15 under a private law agreement in accordance with Art. 23, paragraph 1 of Law no. 240 of 30 December 2010.

**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The following may participate in the present selection announcement:

External experts, in accordance with Art. 1, paragraph 3, letter C of the Regulation governing the stipulation of teaching agreements. An excellent knowledge of the English language and a documented teaching experience in English developed for several years at University master level are required to candidates.

Applications shall be evaluated by a commission appointed by the Head of Department.

The evaluation will be based on the applicant's academic and professional CV and will also take into account any evaluations regarding an applicant's previous teaching experience.

The commission will evaluate the applications and draw up a proposal that will be submitted to the Board of Administration of the University of Padova. After the Board of Administration has made its decision, the winner of each evaluation will be notified by email.

## DUTIES

Winners shall carry out the envisaged teaching duties strictly according to the Academic Calendar:

**Lessons period: second semester: from 2nd March to 12th June . Examination period: from 15th June to 25th July**

They shall also sit on examination commissions for their subject, and hold office hours for students.

The consideration shall be paid once the Head of the Department of Civil, Environmental and Architectural Engineering (I.C.E.A.) has ascertained that teaching duties have been completed fully. See the enclosed table for the consideration.

**MANDATORY ITEMS: In the application the candidate must specify the course title. Each candidate can apply to both courses.**

Should teaching duty be completed partly, the consideration shall be paid proportionally to the teaching duties carried out.

Should teaching duty envisage examinations, the consideration shall be paid once the examinations have been registered correctly.

Foreign winners resident abroad may be entitled to an advance payment (maximum 40%) one month after they have entered into the agreement.
