Diploma

At the end of the courses students having completed the Master curriculum will receive: Joint International Master Degree in Sustainable Territorial Development delivered by Università degli studi di Padova, KU Leuven and Université Paris 1 Panthéon Sorbonne.

The joint master degree will be recognized also as a Brazilian Master degree by the Universidade Catolica Dom Bosco only for the students having spent the 4th semester in that University.
